



What is a “Time”?

Rev 1:3 Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

The Bible clearly distinguishes “times” from “years” in Galatians 4:10.

Gal 4:10 Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years.

The following two verses show that half the tribulation is three and a half “times”.

Rev 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Dan 7:25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

How long is a “time”?

Rev 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

This shows the fixed distance of time from the beginning of the tribulation to the midpoint. If you divide this by 30 you get 42 months, which is verified in...

Rev 13:5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.

Therefore, if:

Half Tribulation = 3.5 “times” AND Half Tribulation = 1260 days,

We can deduce algebraically that:

1 “time” = 360 days.
